## 1. Forward

Cyber Viewer allows you to view or print the Player's Lounge file stored on your computer. Cyber Viewer can is compatible with Player's Lounge files from either the original Cyber Twin CT amplifier or the Cyber Twin SE amplifier.

Please note that this software will not fetch the Player's Lounge from the Cyber Twin (SE) amplifier, the Player's Lounge files have to be stored on your computer. The Player's Lounge files can be stored on your computer using a software such as Cyber Commander CT, Cyber Commander SE, or any other software that can capture the raw MIDI dump from the Cyber Twin (SE) amplifier (without modification) and save it to file on your computer. The raw MIDI Dump must be unmodified or else Cyber Viewer will not be able to display the Player's Lounge. Cyber Commander CT and Cyber Commander SE can save the Cyber Twin's (or the SE's) Player's Lounge as \*.pre files on your computer.

Once the MIDI Dump, or the \*.pre file is stored as a file on your computer, Cyber Viewer can be used to view a summary of the Player's Lounge. The summary is a row-by-row listing of the Player's Lounge Preset Number, Preset Name, Tone Stack and Location, Drive Circuit, and Effect used. You may print the summary of the Player's Lounge or simply view it.

If you have software that can save the Player's Lounge as a raw, unmodified MIDI Dump from the Cyber Twin (SE) amplifier, Cyber Viewer can display or print this Player's Lounge file. However, Cyber Viewer was intended to complement Cyber Commander CT or Cyber Commander SE software and it will display all \*.pre (Player's Lounge) files produced Cyber Commander CT or Cyber Commander SE. The Cyber Commander CT and Cyber Commander SE software are available from [www.generalcybersystems.com](http://www.generalcybersystems.com) .

Please note that Cyber Commander CT was designed to work with the original Fender Cyber Twin amplifier and Cyber Commander SE was designed to work with the Fender Cyber Twin SE amplifier. Cyber Commander CT will not work the Fender Cyber Twin SE amplifier, and Cyber Commander SE will not work with the original Cyber Twin amplifier.

## 2. Software Installation

The installation is fairly simple and straightforward. Simply run the installer and it will setup the desktop icon. Installation will require that you read and accept the End User License Agreement (EULA).

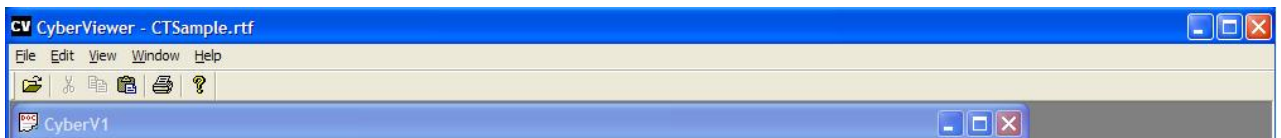
Once installed, Cyber Viewer is ready for use. No software activation is required.

### 3. Quick Guide

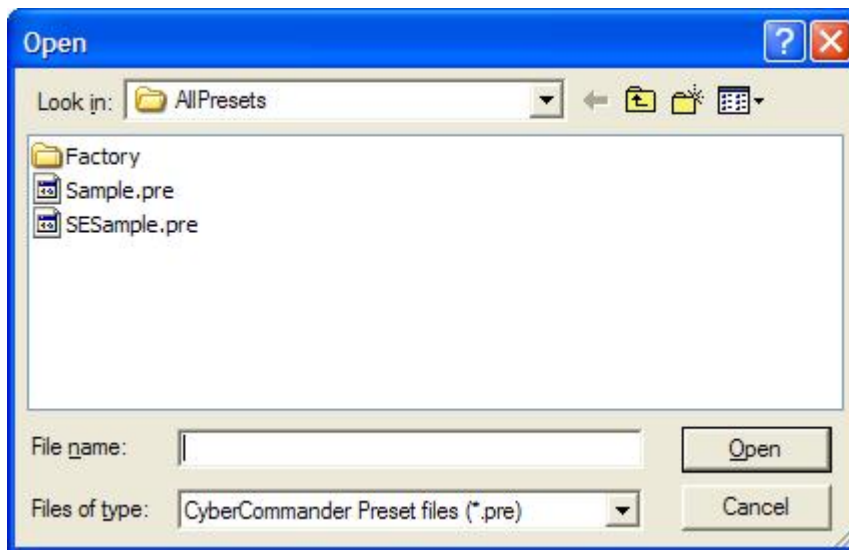
Begin by double clicking on the Cyber Viewer desktop icon:



Then click on File in the Menu Bar (left most item):



Once you click on File, click on Open to open up the file browser:

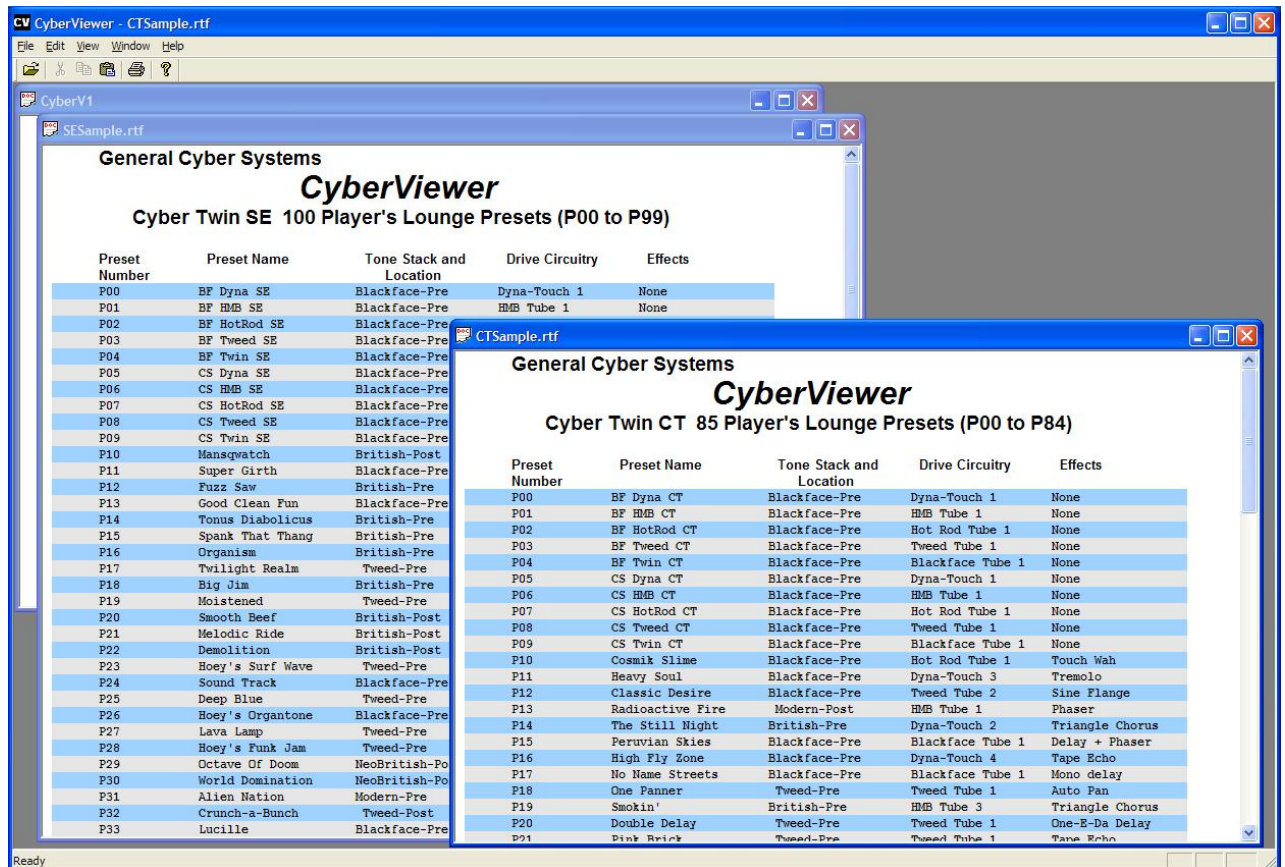


Use the file browser to navigate to where your Player's Lounge Preset files are stored.

In the above depiction, Cyber Viewer will filter out all file types except for \*.pre file types. This is the normal mode of operation when used with Cyber Commander CT or Cyber Commander SE. You can select all file types by clicking on the down arrow in the Files of type window; however, Cyber Viewer will work only with Player's Lounge files from a raw MIDI Dump derived from the Cyber Twin amplifier or from Player's Lounge files (\*.pre) created by Cyber Commander CT or Cyber Commander SE.

Once you find the particular Player's Lounge files (in the case above, they are Sample.pre and SESample.pre), click on the desired Player's Lounge file (SESample.pre for example) and "open" it by clicking on the Open button. Once that is done, a summary of the Player's Lounge will be displayed.

In this example, two files, one for the original Cyber Twin and one for the Cyber Twin SE were selected and are displayed below:



You can print each pane by first clicking on it, then clicking on File in the Menu Bar followed by a click on Print button to print the pane.

That's all that there's to it. Cyber Viewer is a simple Player's Lounge viewer and printer.

**UPDATES / UPGRADES:** You may install and use a modified version, update, or upgrade of the Software only if you have a validly licensed version of the Software being modified,

updated, or upgraded. If you download, install, copy, or otherwise use a modified version, update, or upgrade of the Software, then this Agreement terminates as to the previous version of the Software, and you then have a license only to such modified version, update, or upgrade of the Software under the terms and conditions of this Agreement.
